Club scores £500 from recycling firm

A FOOTBALL club has secured a result after a £500 donation from a collections, clearance and recycling firm.

St Margaretsbury FC will be able to buy goals and other equipment following the donation from Waste King.

The club, which was originally called Stanstead Abbots when it was formed in 1894, moved to the village and changed its name in 1962.

Chairman Gary Stock said: "The club couldn't enjoy its level of facilities without help from the likes of Waste King."

The donation was prompted by a request from John Waites, who is connected with the club and whose London-based City Interiors firm regularly uses Waste King's services.

Managing director of Hemel Hempstead-based Waste King, Glenn Currie, said: "We spend

much of our working lives collecting and recycling things and preventing them going to waste.

"In a way, our support for St Margaretsbury FC is based on a similar premise because, after 118 years of providing opportunities in its locality for people to play football, it would be disappointing to see such a valuable local resource go to waste because of a lack of up-to-date resources."
